Your focus

SeedNL partnership (50%)

You will play a key role in the programme development of the SeedNL partnership to increase access to improved and high quality seeds in LMICs more in particular. You will carry out this role in close collaboration with the SeedNL Team and partners, guided by NFP's multi-stakeholder approach. Your focus within Seed NL will be on:

- Facilitating and organising (international) learning and dialogue exchange especially on complex or sensitive issues notably with respect to ago-biodiversity and genetic resources in the seed sector.

- Managing and further developing key resources such as the Seed Laws Toolbox and scaling outreach
- Maintaining and strengthen strengthening relevant networks in the seed sector including the NGO network

Other partnerships (50%)

In addition as a member of NFP's partnership building team you will support the development of new initiatives that contribute to food system transitions in LMICs, contributing to NFP's broader partnership portfolio. Additionally, you will contribute to the development of NFP through organisational learning and team development.
